# NH Soccer Referee Program

## State Director of Assessment & Instruction Report State Referee Committee (SRC) Meeting: April 2020

### 2020 Training Summary:

- 8 New Grassroots Referee Courses (4 in the summer and 4 in the winter). There were 420 course spots of which 198 spots were filled (47% fill rate).
- 20 Recertifying Grassroots Referee In-Person courses. There were 850 course spots of which 414 spots were filled (49% fill rate).
- 4 Recertifying Grassroots Referee Virtual courses.
- Online Regional referee course.
- 1 Futsal New Referee Course.
- Online Futsal Recertification course.
- Online Futsal Regional Referee Recertification Course (delayed due to US Soccer not having published the curricula).
- Online Assignor course.
- Online Assignor Recertification course.
- Online Grassroots Assessor course.
- Online Regional Assessor course.
- Online Grassroots Instructor course.
- Online Regional Instructor course.

Virtual Training (Due to COVID-19, the decision was made to cancel any remaining in-person courses and present content in a virtual environment. This decision was made for safety in mid-March and affected two scheduled recertification classes and two scheduled new referee classes.)

- New Referee Class
  - Referee's signed up for classes at the time of cancellation were offered the ability to attend a virtual class, transfer to a class in the summer of 2020 or receive a refund. Out of 50 total registrations, 26 chose to take the virtual class, 3 requested a refund and the remainder will transfer to a summer class.
  - Created a digital screencast of parent portion of the New Referee class.
  - Developed an interactive virtual course presented using Zoom and Nearpod that satisfied the US Soccer in-person training requirements.
  - Trained and rehearsed virtual class with a total of 4 instructors
  - US Soccer Referee Department staff members Rick Eddy (Director of Referee Development), Nicole Idowu (Director of Referee Operations), and Pedro Trejo (Referee Development Manager) also attended the virtual New Referee class as observers.
  - Debriefed and reflected with NH instructors and US Soccer staff.
- Recertifying Referee Class
  - 4 virtual classes offered for referees (57 attended)
  - Opened to coaches (26 attended) and parents (3 attended)
  - Encouraged SRC members attend

### Assessment Program:

- Worked with Cullen Madden to develop and acquire ID badges for all assessors
- Provided feedback to US Soccer regarding Referee Mentor Class
- Received requests from recreational programs to coach/mentor referees

### Other:

- Provided feedback to US Soccer regarding Regional Referee Class
- Attended numerous webinars conducted by US Soccer
- Attend NHSA annual meeting



## State Referee Administrator Report – April 2020

- 2020 Referee Registration
  - Referee
    - Multiple recertification and new referee had been scheduled
    - Overall referee numbers down for 2020. Follows trend being seen nationwide in both large and small states
    - Due to COVID-19 situation in-person classes cancelled
    - Virtual Recertification Sessions
      - Opened to coaches to attend
      - Two sessions to date with two more scheduled this week
        - 48% Referees
        - 52% Coaches & Parents
      - Sessions have been well received given current situation
    - Virtual New Grassroots Training
      - Took place of last to in-person scheduled classes
      - 28 Attendees plus 3 US Soccer Referee Office observers
      - Received feedback from US Soccer Director of Referee Development
      - Overall session went well and received well
    - **Kudos to John Breda (State Director of Referee Instruction) on effort to set up and organize virtual training!!!**
  - NH SRC Other Activities
    - SRA & SDI asked to participate on US Soccer Technical Group for New Grassroots Field Training for consistency in deliverables-
    - NH SRC social media presence (Facebook) released
      - Showing positive impact
      - Starting with Facebook
      - Looking at other options as well
    - US Soccer Referee Administrator Workshop in Chicago cancelled due COVID-19
      - Series of webinars on major topics held week of Apr 6-10
      - SRA, SDI/SDA, SYRA attended sessions for updates
    - SRA asked to participate on US Soccer Panel for Recruitment, Retention of Referees. Initial work complete with more to follow
    - Working with M. Chagnon on referees for Adult Summer League transition to NHA.
      - Some technical difficulties in getting assignor class set-up. Expect week of Apr 12-18 to be finalized
      - Date of referee certification is hazy right now due to COVID-19 situation. Mid-May is target and will use virtual training if needed
    - Working with VP Recreation on potential sessions for Recreation League Referee coaching sessions
