General information of the job of a Referee Mentor

Context of the performance environment

The Referee Mentor:

- Mentors U.S. Soccer Grassroots Referees in youth and adult competitions
- Facilitates referee education sessions sponsored by the competition (youth/adult), State Referee Programs, and/or U.S. Soccer
- Collaborates with competition, State Referee Programs, and/or USSF in training Referee Mentors, new or experienced
- Engages Grassroots referees using an interactive and integrative dialogue to guide & support their development
- Engages with peers to reflect on own performance by offering and accepting feedback

Purpose of the job

The Referee Mentor:

- Contributes to the development of U.S. Soccer Grassroots Referees
- Inspires match officials to self-develop and to improve from game to game
- Facilitates a fair, fun, and safe environment conducive for learning where Grassroots
 Referees and Referee Mentors engage in training
- Facilitates understanding and application the Laws of the Game for Grassroots Referees and Referee Mentors
- Provides constructive feedback about performance of Grassroots Referees to create a positive learning experience

Responsibilities and roles

The Referee Mentor:

- Prepares prior to the game, offers feedback at half-time (where applicable), and mentors and reflects with the referee team after the game
- Takes notes during the game that highlight positive behavior by the referee team and notes the areas of improvement
- Guides the referee team in the reflection session after the game
- Takes ownership of self-development through on-line and field session opportunities offered by the competition, State Referee Programs, and/or U.S. Soccer
- Prepares prior to an education session to deliver the best experience for audience (Grassroots Referees and/or Referee Mentors)
- Reflects after each task to develop a plan for self-improvement

Tasks and processes of the Referee Mentor

Leading field sessions

- Applies the P.E.A.C.E model to prepare for and engage with Grassroots Referees and/or Referee Mentors in field session activities
- Guides the decision-making process that match officials apply during the game
- Self-reflects and documents on his/her performance of this task

Leading video analysis sessions

- Applies the P.E.A.C.E model to prepare for and engage with Grassroots Referees and/or Referee Mentors in video analysis sessions
- Understands the current Laws of the Game, considerations, and interpretations
- Guides the decision-making process that match officials apply during the game
- Self-reflects and documents on his/her performance of this task

Observing performance of Grassroots Referees

- Understands the game and performance environment
- Notes the challenges presented to individual match official members, identifies key match incidents, and facilitates discussion among the crew to reach learning outcomes
- Facilitates the post-game team reflection
- Connects with the referee team by clearly and confidently communicating recommendations/suggestions for match officials to improve during the second half of the game (where applicable)
- Understands the profiles of the match officials to enhance coaching the referee team
 to improve competencies in 'Officiating the Game' (a task of the referee) including: 1)
 making decisions that impact the game, 2) understanding the game, 3) demonstrating
 physical aptitude, 4) communicating clearly and confidently, and 5) leading the
 referee team
- Self-reflects and documents on his/her performance of this task

Applying the P.E.A.C.E model to engage match officials and referee mentors/coaches

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Communicate with organizers to ensure that required personnel and equipment will be available
- Review the practical exercises prior to the field session

Guiding the decision-making process that enhances accuracy of on field decisions

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Summarize decision-making process that helps to increase accuracy of decisions during the game
- Understand the decision-making process that match officials use during the game
- Understand that for each decision, the match official must 1) move to an optimal position to see the player actions, 2) interpret the observed player/coach actions, and 3) decide based on those actions
- Understand US Soccer's, FIFA's and IFAB's resources on topics including:
- Continuing Education
- Considerations
- Laws of the Game and practical guidelines
- Connect specific topics with decisionmaking process during the game

- Review of best practices for incidents in the game to increase accuracy of decisions by referees
- Increased knowledge and understanding of decision-making process by referees
- Opportunity for learning and development of referees and Referee Mentors
- Increased understanding of the Laws of the Game and the Rules of Competition

Applying the P.E.A.C.E model during video analysis sessions

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Research the audience prior to the session
- Understand the methodology for FIFA Teaching Material presentation
- Review and practice with FIFA FUTURO or US Soccer video library material
- Engage the audience with decision, discussion, demonstrations, and considerations based on the video clip
- Use platform skills to guide and facilitate the engagement with the audience
- Adjust the environment to benefit the session
- Prepare content based on FUTURO teaching material and video library
- Relate content with audience experience

- Clear and confident analysis of the content (video and key points)

- Active-learning environment not only lecture

- Understand the Laws of the Game, considerations, and interpretations
- Understand theoretical and practical concepts important for the Profile of the Grassroots Referee
- Interpret the Laws of the Game based on current considerations

- Effective resource for referees
- Offer current and correct information for development of referees
- Mentor referees to review appropriate material (Laws of the Game & considerations) to arrive to accurate interpretations & decisions
- Resource for continuing education lifelong learning

- Clearly communicate applicable considerations and corresponding Laws of the Game for each video clip

Noting the challenges faced by referees during the game

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Observe the match and view the entire referee team
- Time stamp during the game when the referee team demonstrates good decision making and areas for improvement
- Designate level of competitiveness for the game

Outcomes:

- Observations from multiple positions around the field of play
- Feedback for each member of the referee team
- Positive points and areas for improvement to share with referees in the post-game reflection

Guiding and facilitating the post-game reflection with the referee team

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Guide discussion to about positives observed during the game and areas for improvement
- Reinforce decision-making process that contributed to correct decisions in the game
- Offer options/solutions to address areas for improvement in the next game

Outcomes:

- Trusting, learning environment
- Clear discussion and feedback
- Next steps to improve areas that will improve decision-making in future games

Connecting with match officials by clearly communicating recommendations and solutions for improvement

The Referee Coach is able to:

- Establish a positive relationship with match officials
- Understand the current practical guidelines for match officials training
- Derive appropriate solutions and options based on incidents in the game using current practical guidelines
- Clearly communicate each solution and option for referee and/or assistant referee
- Explain the rationale to support the solution or option

- Trusting, learning environment
- Clear discussion and written feedback regarding Key Match Incidents
- Reinforcement of positive behavior that leads to accurate decisions
- Next steps to improve areas that will improve decision making in future games

Understanding the Profile of the Grassroots Referee

The Referee Mentor is able to:

- Understand the current Profile of the Grassroots Referee
- Understand the *task of the referee*: Officiating the Game
- Clearly and confidently describe coaching points to help referees improve for their next game
- Clearly explain the decision-making process in the context of each game

- Referees inspired to develop and refine competencies to maintain or enhance the corresponding profile *tasks* and *competencies*
- Action plan and strategy to apply refined skill in their next game
- Increased understanding of decisionmaking process that involves position and movement, communication, and player management by referees
